Job Summary:

The gas dock attendant is an important position at Bay Point as our members depend upon the ability to purchase fuel and pump out their boat before they leave to out on the lake or bay. This is a fast-paced position on most weekends and holidays.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Cordially greet members and guests
- Assist boater with tying up and untying boat at the gas dock
- Understand safety rules and the need to enforce them in fueling and pumping out watercraft
- Assist member in pumping out boat
- Ability to respond to emergency situations should they arise
- Conducts dock checks as necessary
- Assist members and guests with purchases
- Ability to ring up sales on the POS, make change
- Check IDs for those making beer purchases, must be 19 years of age or older to ring up purchase
- Able to open and close POS including counting money and balancing account
- Stocking merchandise on shelves including pricing merchandise as necessary
- Provide departing members and guests with a thank you and good bye
- Adhere daily dress code standards (uniform and appearance)
- Any and all other duties assigned to you

- Possess an outgoing personality
- Ability to communicate professionally and effectively
- Ability to maintain composure in a fast-paced environment.
- Ability to drive golf cart
- Must be able to work a flexible schedule based on operational needs including early evenings, weekends and holidays.
- Physical requirements are as follows: standing, sitting, hearing, speaking, reaching, lifting, pushing and carrying up to 30 pounds, bending and walking.
- Be able to stand on your feet for several hours.
