

Shores Busser

Seasonal, Full- or Part-time, approximated starting and ending dates: 4/1/21 to 11/13/21

Job Summary:

A busser is someone who is attentive to customers and co-workers so that the guests dining in the restaurant have the best service possible. Cleaning tables, gliders and chairs, and quickly removing dirty dishes are all part of a busser's day. The busser will assist the wait staff and bartenders by setting tables, filling beverage glasses, and providing silverware. They will occasionally serve food and beverages to guests at tables being professional, friendly and striving to meet the highest standards of quality customer service.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Stocking wait staff serving stations with napkins, utensils, trays, condiments, and salt and pepper containers
- Removing guest's dirty dishes and utensils, able to move and clean quickly in a fast-paced environment
- Delivering used dishes and utensils to the kitchen for cleaning
- Assisting dishwashers to scrape, stack, or load dishes into dishwasher as needed
- Vacuuming, sweeping or mopping dining room
- Removing trash and recycling; replacing trash bags
- Cleaning up guest spills as needed
- Directing guests to restrooms or exits as needed
- Greeting guests and if needed, escorting guests to tables
- Clearing table as guests complete their meals and preparing tables for next guests
- Following and maintaining all sanitation and safety procedures
- Performing closing activities such as cleaning chairs and tables, stacking chairs, preparing stations for the morning shift
- Additional duties may include assisting kitchen staff with preparing ingredients and cleaning kitchen surfaces
- Adhere daily dress code standards (uniform and appearance)
- Any and all other duties assigned to you

Skills and Qualifications:

- Excellent customer service and people skills
- In-depth knowledge of food sanitation and safety policies
- Physically able to wipe down table tops, chairs, and sliders; able to pick up debris from the floor; able to carry 25 or more pounds; able to push vacuum or mop
- Physically able to stand and move during the length of shift; able to bend and kneel through shift
- Ability to work in a team
- High energy level
